Technical Committee 188 – Working Group 20 – Windows, portlights, hatches, deadlights and doors

ISO/WD 12216, Windows, portlights, hatches, deadlights and doors

In attendance were experts from France, the Netherlands, Norway, Belgium, England, Finland, United States, and the HAS Consultant.

1. Upon direction of the European Commission, all referenced standards must be dated, or if not, must be submitted with a justification for why the standard is not dated.
2. ISO 12216 was submitted and approved as a DIS and had 360 submitted comments for WG review and determination.
3. Removed the term “prefabricated” from appliance samples to be tested. Now all appliances shall be tested. (“Prefabricated” was the term used in the RCD.)
4. Redefined “clear opening dimensions” – the dimension of a void within a structure or a frame through which objects or people may pass.
5. Numerous editorial comments.
6. Next Meeting: At ISO standards week, June 2018, in Toronto.
