On Street Parking
 On street parking is available on most streets. North of Kennedy Blvd. is free on weeknights after 6pm and weekends. Between Whiting and Kennedy is enforced Mon - Sat. 8am - 8pm and Sun. 1p - 8p. Between Garrison Channel and Whiting is enforced Mon - Sat. 8am - midnight. Rates vary. Change is available from Parking Enforcement Officers.

In-Town Trolley Network
 Hop aboard HARTline's Route 96, with the rubber-wheeled yellow trolleys, next time you need to get around downtown. Easy access to Tampa Convention Center, library, Harbour Island, Marion Transit Center and more. Every 10-15 minutes. Route 98 will take passengers between Hyde Park and downtown. Seven days a week/hours vary. Rides cost \$.50/ride, \$3.25/day or \$5/month. www.HARTline.org or 254-4278

TECOline Streetcar
 Let a nostalgic air-conditioned streetcar whisk you between historic Ybor City and downtown, stopping at Tampa Convention Center, Florida Aquarium, Garrison Seaport, St. Pete Times Forum and the Channelside Entertainment Complex. \$2/ride or \$4/day. www.tecolinestreetcar.org or 254-4278

Hooters Channelside Express
 Fast, Fun and Free trolley service every 10 minutes directly from Lykes Gaslight Square to the Channelside Entertainment Complex. Runs 11:30am - 2:30pm weekdays.

Marion Street Transit Parkway Free Fare Zone
 Downtowners can ride any HARTline bus for FREE along the Marion Street Transit Parkway between the Marion Transit Center (near I-275) and Whiting Street. Just hop on any bus approximately every 4 minutes at one of the convenient stations located along the transit parkway and ride to your downtown destination.

Taxi-Cabs
 Taxi rides within the "In-Town Zone" are \$3 each for 2 or more people. A \$22 per car flat rate between this zone and the airport.

Bicycle Facilities
 Bicycle Racks — there are 60 bike racks conveniently scattered throughout the Downtown area. Be sure to provide your own lock and always wear a helmet. All buses and trolleys have bicycle racks installed on the front. There are a number of shower and locker facilities available.

Commute Options
 Save yourself money and stress while doing your part to combat poor air quality by not always driving alone to work. We can help you choose which option(s) work best for you — carpool, vanpool, bus, walk, bike or telework. www.tampabayrideshare.org

Emergency Ride Home Program
 Anyone who uses a commute option other than driving alone at least 2 days per week is eligible to receive a free taxi ride home from work in case of an emergency, illness or unexpected overtime. www.tampabayrideshare.org
