



#### YOUR STATISTICS REPORT

The NMMA MONTHLY STATISTICAL REPORT is one of the most comprehensive and detailed manufacturers shipment reports in all American industry. The credit for this goes to the hundreds of progressive companies that contribute to it.

#### WHAT IS A CONTROL GROUP?

A Control Group is composed of a fixed number of companies that manufactures the same type of product. In the MONTHLY STATISTICAL REPORT, there are fourteen groups (e.g. outboard motor control group, fiberglass outboard boat group, etc.). Each of these groups is composed of important, stable companies, sufficiently representative of their segments of the industry to indicate, in statistical comparisons, the movements of the total production of their products.

New companies are added into the control groups only at the beginning of a calendar year. These companies have reported one year of monthly shipments before entering the control group so that valid comparisons between months and years can be drawn. The calendar year for all control groups is January 1 through December 31.

When a company first joins the program its reports are held by a fiduciary until a year's data is complete. These figures are then combined into the prior year's data of the total control group at the beginning of the new year.

#### HOW BIG ARE CONTROL GROUPS?

The control groups now being utilized are largest - both in dollars and units reported - in the history of the industry. Over three billion dollars worth of shipments are reported in a calendar year. This year, and in the years to come, new companies will be added so that these reports will increase in value to you. Major groups within the report represent as much as two/thirds of entire industry production. Some of the groups report a greater percentage of total production.

#### DO CONTROL GROUPS CHANGE FROM YEAR-TO-YEAR?

Yes. The companies in the control groups reflect changes in the industry. Some companies leave the recreational marine industry; others expand into different product lines. Therefore, at the beginning of each year, new control groups are developed and historical data is revised to reflect these changes. Comparisons of monthly and year-to-date data with the totals shown for the prior year are comparisons for identical companies. This fulfills the primary object of the report, which is to indicate year-to-year shipment trends.

Also, each year companies that have not previously reported are added to the control groups. The ultimate goal is to have every company in the industry contribute to the report. While this is not yet realized, the list of reporting companies reflects that a majority of the major companies do participate. This indicates the importance that they attach to having a monthly indicator, with supporting detail, of shipment trends in the industry.

#### HOW ARE THE VARIOUS CONTROL GROUPS AND REPORTING CATEGORIES DETERMINED?

The Statistics Committee of NMMA decides on all categories to be used, as well as which new control groups are to be reported. These decisions are normally based upon a survey of the reporting participants, as well as consideration of whether or not the categories would reveal the shipment data of an individual member. The Statistics Committee consists entirely of industry representatives, who as member of NMMA contribute their time and knowledge to directing this program. Member suggestions and comments are given consideration and accommodated whenever possible.

NMMA, itself, makes substantial use of these reports in representing the industry in the media, before legislative bodies, and in the development of programs for its members.
